17	Improvements Element covering at least a five-year planning horizon; and,

19	WHEREAS, the County is required to review its Capital Improvements Element ("CIE")
20	at least annually pursuant to § 163.3177(3)(b), Florida Statutes, and update and amend this element
21	of the Comprehensive Plan as necessary; and,
22	
23	WHEREAS, the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners ("BOCC"), following
24	public hearing, approved an undated CIE, a copy attached as Exhibit 'A' hereto, as an amendment
25	to its Comprehensive Plan and referred to as CPAM-05-08;
26	
27	WHEREAS, the County subsequently transmitted CPAM-05-08 to the Florida Department
28	of Community Affairs ("DCA") for review pursuant to the Act, and was assigned DCA No. 05CIE1;
29	and,
30	
31	WHEREAS, DCA has reviewed CPAM-05-08 and prepared an objections,
32	recommendations, and comments (ORC) report concerning same; and,
33	
34	WHEREAS, the BOCC conducted a second public hearing on March 15, 2006 in connection
35	with final adoption of the updated CIE (CPAM-05-08) as an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan.

SECTION 1. Amending Capital Improvement Element of Comprehensive Plan. The updated CIE (CPAM-05-08; DCA No. 05CIE1), attached as Exhibit 'A' hereto, is hereby approved and adopted and Hernando County's Comprehensive Plan is amended accordingly.

SECTION 2. Execution and transmittal. The Chairperson of the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners is hereby authorized to execute this ordinance. County staff shall transmit an executed copy of this ordinance to the Florida Department of Community Affairs within ten working days of adoption hereof.

SECTION 3. Severability. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Effective date. The updated CIE (CPAM-05-08; DCA No. 05CIE1) shall take effect, and be considered an amendment to the Hernando County Comprehensive Plan, upon DCA issuing a final order finding same to be in compliance pursuant to § 163.3189(2), Florida Statutes.
