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ORDINANCE NO.: 2006-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION B OF THE HERNANDO COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN RELATING **CAPITAL** TO THE IMPROVEMENTS IMPLEMENTATION, AMENDING SECTION D RELATING TO FUTURE LAND USE MAP MAPPING CRITERIA & LAND USES ALLOWED, AND AMENDING SECTION E RELATING TO THE SPECIAL FEATURES MAPS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA: ADOPTING CPAM-06-05; ADOPTING CPAM-06-06; ADOPTING CPAM-06-09; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 1985, the Florida Legislature adopted the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act as set forth in §§ 163.3161 through 163.3215 Florida Statutes (the "Act"); and,

WHEREAS, on June 7, 1989, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 89-9 which adopted the Hernando County Comprehensive Plan, as such Plan or portions thereof have been subsequently amended ("Comprehensive Plan"); and,

WHEREAS, the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners ("BOCC") previously transmitted CPAM-06-05, CPAM-06-06 and CPAM-06-09 to the Florida Department of Community Affairs ("DCA") for review pursuant to the Act, and were assigned, respectively, DCA No.06-2; and,

WHEREAS, CPAM-06-05, CPAM-06-06 and CPAM-06-09 (respectively, attached as Exhibits A, B and C hereto and made a part hereof) are now ready for final adoption by the BOCC; and,

WHEREAS, the BOCC conducted a second public hearing on December 13, 2006 in connection with final adoption of CPAM-06-05, CPAM-06-06 and CPAM-06-09 as amendments to the County's adopted Comprehensive Plan.

NOW THEREFORE:

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF **HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. Adopting CPAM-06-05, CPAM-06-06, and CPAM-06-09. The BOCC hereby approves and adopts CPAM-06-05 (Exhibit A hereto), CPAM-06-06 (Exhibit B hereto), and CPAM-06-09 (Exhibit C hereto).

SECTION 2. Execution. The Chairperson of the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners is hereby authorized to execute this ordinance.

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SECTION 3. Transmittal to Florida Department of Community Affairs. County staff shall transmit an executed copy of this ordinance to the Florida Department of Community Affairs within ten (10) working days of adoption hereof.

SECTION 4. Severability. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon filing with the Florida Secretary of State; however, the adopted amendments CPAM-06-05, CPAM-06-06, CPAM06-09 shall take effect, and be considered amendments to the Hernando County Comprehensive Plan, upon DCA issuing a final order finding same to be in compliance pursuant to § 163.3189(2), Florida Statutes.

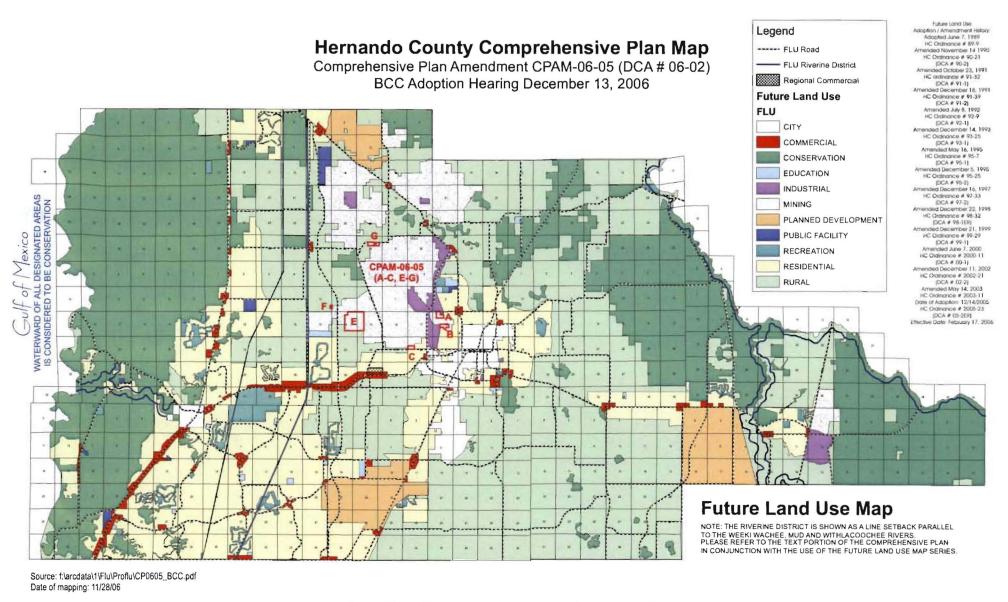

MINING

- Mapping Criteria. This classification consists of the area north of S.R. 50 within the outer boundaries of mining zoned properties existing as of June 7, 1989, and lands which receive comprehensive plan amendment approval to the mining land use category after June 7, 1989. The maximum Floor Area Ratio shall be .1.
- Purpose. To allow for the extraction of mineral resources where impact on major residential areas will be minimal.
- Land Use Allowed. Mining and ancillary mining activities, and agriculture.

Additional Clarifications

- The land designated as mining through the approval of comprehensive plan amendment 93-1, is restricted to the excavation of hard rock limerock, soft rock limerock, sand mining and other activities or operations ancillary to the excavation of the hard and soft limerock and sand. Further, no blasting, drilling, or extraction shall occur within 7,500' 3,000' of Brookridge.
- CPAM-93-1 shall meet the following stricter standards for environmental protection and buffering:
 - Standard 1: An Environmental Assessment shall be conducted and evaluated as part of the mining permit process, which will include a mapping of environmentally sensitive lands.

Standard 2: Resource extraction shall not be allowed in "environmentally sensitive" areas which cannot be restored. "Environmentally sensitive" is defined to include wetlands, rivers, streams, lakes, springs, coastal floodplains, habitat of threatened and endangered species and species of special concern county-mapped prime groundwater recharge areas, listed historically significant sites, and prime agricultural soils historically in use as cropland. "Restoration" is defined as restoring the type, nature, and function of the ecosystem in existence prior to mining.

- Standard 3: There shall be a 100 foot buffer between resource extraction and rivers, streams, lakes, springs, or wetlands that are not mined.
- Standard 4: Blasting shall not occur within 500 feet of a protected structure. Protected Structures are any dwelling, public building, school, church, cemetery, or commercial or institutional building on lands not controlled by the operator of the mine.
- In addition to the above, this property shall also be subject to the standards of the Hernando County Mining Ordinance.
