**SECTION 4. Publication**. This ordinance shall be published in accordance with law.

SECTION 5. Severability. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon filing with the Florida Secretary of State; however, pursuant to 163.3187(3)(c), Florida Statutes, CPAM-08-04 shall not become effective until 31 days after adoption by the BOCC (the date below), unless challenged within 30 days from the date hereof. In the event of any timely challenge, CPAM-08-04 shall not become effective until the state land planning agency (DCA) or the Administration Commission, respectively, issues a final order determining that this adopted small scale development amendment is in compliance.








## **Hernando County Comprehensive Plan Map**


