Use of leased property is subject to covenants, conditions and restrictions applicable to the particular property; laws, rules, regulations and orders of any state or Federal agency with jurisdiction over the property, including but not limited to the Federal Aviation Administration, the State of Florida Department of Transportation, and applicable Florida Statutes and <u>County</u> ordinances of the Board; as well as and standard or negotiated lease terms approved by the county.

Parties interested in entering into negotiations for lease of particular parcels should contact the Hernando County Airport Manager/Industrial Park Administrator, 16110 Aviation Loop <u>15800 Flight Path</u> Drive, Brooksville FL 34609, (352) 754-4061, FAX 799-1711. Parties offering lease terms which are most favorable overall, in the reasonable judgment of County officers or employees with delegated leasing responsibility, with respect to Hernando County's interests in any particular parcel or parcels may be tendered lease documents for execution. Should any party and the Airport Manager agree to the terms of any proposed lease, on such lease agreement form approved by the County Attorney's Office, the proposed lease will be scheduled for recommended approval before the Board. Interested parties All persons are hereby placed on notice that the transmittal of such a proposed lease documents to the Board for recommended approval shall constitute be construed as a "bid" for lease of the specified property parcel(s) at the terms provided in the documents lease. Interested parties Any other person wishing to bid on the particular parcel(s) subject to tentative upon which a recommended lease documents has been submitted to the Board must propose in writing, and deliver to the Airport Manager, leasing terms which are deemed by the Board in its sole discretion to be more advantageous to the County before the date and time set by Board agenda for action on the documents recommended lease under consideration; if no such proposal is made, the tentative lease documents shall be subject to approval and execution by the Board other proposed leases are timely received by the County on the same parcel(s) of land, then the recommended lease shall be deemed the only "bid" and no further

3		discretion, will determine which bid for lease, if any, is the most

7		for lease upon determination that such $bid(s)$ is (are) not in the best		
8		interests of the County as determined solely in the exercise of the		
9		legislative discretion vested in the Board under the Constitution and laws

SECTION IV. Inclusion in the Code. To this end, any section or subsection of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section, "article," or other appropriate designation.

SECTION V. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately and shall be filed with the Department of State.
