Section 1. Expansion of the Geographic Boundaries of the Hernando County Emergency	
Medical Services MSTU	
The geographical description of the Hernando County Emergency Medical Services	
Municipal Services Taxing Unit, as contained in Appendix "A" of Section 24-1057, Hernando	
County Code, is hereby amended as described in Appendix "A" as attached hereto and made a part	
hereof.	
Section 2. Creation of the Hernando County Emergency Fire Rescue and Suppression	
Services MSTU	
A new division to be contained within Article IV of Chapter 12 of the Hernando County Code	
is created to read as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERE NDG COUNTY: Section 1. Expansion of the Geographic Boundaries of the Hernando County Emergency Medical Services MSTU The geographical description of the Hernando County Emergency Medical Services Municipal Services Taxing Unit, as contained in Appendix "A" of Section 24-1057, Hernando County Code, is hereby amended as described in Appendix "A" as attached hereto and made a part hereof. Section 2. Creation of the Hernando County Emergency Fire Rescue and Suppression Services MSTU A new division to be contained within Article IV of Chapter 12 of the Hernando County Code

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1	Findings of Fact and Purpose.
2	It is hereby found by the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County,
3	Florida ("the Board") that emergency fire rescue and suppression services are
4	essential services for the benefit of the health, safety, and welfare of the public. It is
5	further the finding of the Board that the legislature has in F.S. § 125.01(1)(q), as it
6	may be amended from time to time, provided for the creation of an MSTU as a taxing
7	vehicle granting to all counties the taxing flexibility to levy ad valorem taxes within
8	the limits fixed for municipal purposes for the furnishing of municipal services
9	within those areas receiving the benefit of such municipal services. In this instance,
10	the creation of such a MSTU will avoid double taxation of certain county residents
11	and provide a needed and necessary service in other areas of the county. It is the
12	purpose of this division to create an MSTU for the purpose of funding the operations
13	of an emergency fire rescue and suppression services system within the areas
14	described herein.
15	Creation and Boundaries of Unit.
16	The Hernando County Emergency Fire Rescue and Suppression Services Municipal
17	Service Taxing Unit ("the Unit") is hereby created for the purpose of funding the
18	operations of an emergency fire rescue and suppression services system within the
19	area described in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein. The Unit may
20	be described by a legal description or a map. Where there is a conflict or discrepancy

1	between the map and the legal description, the legal description shall prevail.
2	Budget and Millage.
3	The Board shall annually adopt the budget for the Unit pursuant to Chapter 129 and
4	F.S. ch. 200, as they may be amended from time to time. The Board shall establish
5	the ad valorem rate for this unit by resolution pursuant to the provisions of the
6	Florida Statutes.
7	Duties of the Board of County Commissioners.
8	The Board shall have the discretion to fund emergency fire rescue and suppression
9	services within the MSTU up to the limits established by the Florida Constitution and
10	Florida Statutes. Besides funding emergency fire rescue and suppression services by
11	an MSTU other methods of funding may be used as allowed by law. The Board has
12	full authority to levy ad valorem taxes up to the limits permitted by the Florida
13	Constitution and the laws of Florida and to use the funds for the operation of the
14	Unit.
15	Capital Reserves.
16	The Board is empowered to set up reserves in the budget for the Unit in excess of its
17	estimated expenditures for any fiscal year, for the purpose of creating reasonable
18	reserves for the purchase of equipment and making other necessary capital
19	expenditures or for any other lawful purposes for which reserves may be used.
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
1	Consent of Municipalities.
2	The provisions of this division creating an MSTU shall not be effective within any
3	municipality in Hernando County unless and until such municipality consents by
4	ordinance in accordance with the provisions of F.S. § 125.01(1)(q), as it may be
5	amended from time to time to the imposition of the MSTU within the municipality.
6	The consent of a municipality shall not be required in municipalities that have
7	previously approved the provision of emergency fire rescue and suppression services
8	by Hernando County.
9	Administration.
10	The county administrator shall be responsible for ensuring the administration of the
11	Unit.
12	Section 3. Severability
13	It is declared to be the intent of the board of county commissioners that if any section,
14	subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held
15	unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining
16	portions of this ordinance.
17	Section 4. Inclusion in the Code
18	It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and
19	it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the
20	Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the section of this Ordinance may


- 1 be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be
- 2 changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate designation.
- 3 Section 5. Conflicting Provisions Repealed.
- 4 All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are
- 5 hereby repealed.
- 6 Section 6. Effective Date.
- 7 This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from
- 8 the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance has been filed with said office.
