7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
8	COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY:
9	Section 1. Elimination of Criminal Penalties. Hernando County Code § 18-31 of the
10	Hernando County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
11	Criminal and civil penalties, code enforcement, revocation costs of prosecution.
12	(a) Revocation of a pain management clinic registration certificate may be
13	pursued by the county at any time in addition to code violation enforcement
14	actions specified in this article.
15	(b) Pursuant to section 125.69, Florida Statutes, any person or persons, firm or
16	corporation, or any agent thereof who violates any provision of this section
17	shall be subject to prosecution in the name of the state in the same manner as
18	misdemeanors are prosecuted; and, upon conviction such person shall be
19	punished by a fine not to exceed-five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by
20	imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed sixty (60) days or by both such

fine and imprisonment. Each incident or separate occurrence of an act that 1 2 violates this article shall be deemed a separate offense. 3 (e)(b) Any person or persons, firm or corporation, or any agent thereof who violates any provision of this article may be prosecuted in the manner provided for in 4 chapter 2, article III, of the Hernando County Code of Ordinances. 5 6 (d)(c) The remedies and penalties herein are not intended to be cumulative and the 7 sheriff's office and/or the county may institute any appropriate action or proceedings to prevent, restrain, enjoin, correct or abate a violation of this 8 9 article as allowed by law. 10 (e)(d) In any of the above code enforcement or revocation actions, in the event the 11 county prevails, the entire cost of prosecution, including attorney fees and 12 witness costs are recoverable against the responsible parties, including but 13 not limited to the owner, designated physician or other person Severability. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County 14 Section 2. Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this 15 16 ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the 17 validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. Section 3. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners 18 19 of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall 20 become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the

1 section of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention, and that 2 the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section, "article," or other appropriate designation. 3 Section 4. Conflicting Provisions Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed. 4 5 Section 5. Effective Date.
