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1 County, selected by the board of county commissioners. In addition, the governing
2 body shall appoint an alternate member, designating him or her as such. Such
3 alternate member may act only in the temporary absence or disability of any
4 regular member. The terms of office of such members of such authority shall be for
5 four (4) years or until their successors are appointed and qualified. Terms of office
6 shall commence on the first day of January of the year of appointment and shall
7 expire on the thirty-first day of December of the year of termination. ~~Those members~~
8 ~~actually serving on the aviation authority at the time of the adoption of this ordinance~~
9 ~~[Ordinance No. 98-05] shall constitute the first members of the authority hereby~~
10 ~~created and shall serve until their terms of office then existing shall expire.~~

11 **Section 2. Severability.**

12 It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section,
13 subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held
14 unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining
15 portions of this ordinance.

16 **Section 3. Inclusion in the Code.**

17 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and
18 it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the
19 Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the section of this Ordinance may be
20 renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be

1 changed to "section, "article," or other appropriate designation.

2 **Section 4. Conflicting Provisions Repealed.**

3 All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are
4 hereby repealed.

5 **Section 5. Effective Date.**


6 This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official acknowledgment from
7 the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance has been filed with said office.
