2	AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 8,
3	ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 2, CONSTRUCTION LICENSING CODE, TO REMOVE
4	BONDING REQUIREMENTS AND REFERENCES TO SAME; AMENDING
5	HERNANDO COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 2,
6	CONSTRUCTION LICENSING CODE, REGARDING RETENTION AND
7	POWERS OF SPECIAL MASTER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;
8	PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL
9	OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
10	DATE.
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
12	COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY:
13	Section 1. Qualifications for Practice; Restrictions. Hernando County Code Section 8-
14	29(4) is hereby amended to read as follows, with added text underlined and deleted text struck
15	through:
16	(4) When a state certified contractor desires to engage in contracting in Hernando
17	County, as a prerequisite therefore, he or she shall be required to exhibit and file with
18	the board's principal office a copy of his/her certificate together with applicable
19	insurance and bond. In lieu of the preceding an individual may appear personally
20	with his/her certificate and insurance each time a permit is applied for and picked up.

1	Section 2. Responsibilities. Hernando County Code Section 8-32(4)(b) is hereby amended
2	to read as follows, with added text underlined and deleted text struck through:
3	(b) The board shall adopt rules prescribing the qualifications for financially
4	responsible officers, including net worth and cash <del>, and bonding requirements</del> . These
5	qualifications must be at least as extensive as the requirements for the financial
6	responsibility of qualifying agents.
7	Section 3. Powers of County. Hernando County Code Section 8-45(e) is hereby deleted
8	in its entirety.
9	Section 4. Special Master, Hearings. Hernando County Code Section 8-48(1)(a) is hereby
10	amended to read as follows, with added text underlined and deleted text struck through:
11	(a) There is hereby created, for the purpose of conducting an administrative
12	(formal) hearing pursuant to this code, and the Hernando County Construction Code
13	as adopted by ordinance, the position of special master. The special master shall be
14	selected by the board Hernando County Board of County Commissioners. The special
15	master shall be a member in good standing with the Florida Bar engaged in the
16	practice of law, be familiar with and have an understanding of construction practices,
17	laws, rules and codes associated thereto.
18	Section 5. Special Master, Hearings. Hernando County Code Section 8-48(16) is hereby
19	amended to read as follows, with added text underlined and deleted text struck through:
20	(16) In the case of formal hearings as to licensed contractors, upon conclusion of

1	and within ten (10) days, a special master shall enter a final order of disciplinary
2	action if appropriate. Final orders shall contain findings of fact, conclusions of law,
3	recommended penalty to DBPR (if appropriate), type of disciplinary action
4	(suspension, revocation, or probation), civil penalty amount, costs associated with
5	
5	prosecution and investigation and include any stipulations as applicable or ordered.
6	(a) Such orders shall be submitted for ratification to the chairman of the
7	construction licensing board.
8	1. If the chairman finds material error contained within the order
9	he/she shall remand the order back to the special master with written explanation as
10	to any material error with direction as to how the error can be corrected.
11	Such final orders shall be remedied by the special master and
12	immediately served upon the respondent without further review of the chairman.
13	2. If such an order is consistent with this code and adopted board
14	rules the order shall be ratified by the chairman and immediately served upon the
15	respondent.
16	(b) (a) Such orders should be consistent with requirements set forth in
17	sections 8-65 of this code titled "Final order; appeal".
18	(b) The principal office shall inform the Board of any such orders.
19	

1	Section 6. Administrative Hearings, Formal and Informal (Licensed Contractors, Code
2	Appeals). Hernando County Code Section 8-62(1)(h)(1) is hereby amended to read as follows, with
3	added text underlined and deleted text struck through:
4	1. Liens have been recorded against the property of a contractor's customer for
5	supplies or services ordered by the contractor for the customer's job; the contractor
6	has received funds from the customer to pay for the supplies or services; and the
7	contractor has not had the liens removed from the property by payment or by bond,
8	within seventy-five (75) days after the date of such liens.
9	Section 7. Applications and Examinations. Hernando County Code Section 8-78(1)(c)
10	is hereby amended to read as follows, with added text underlined and deleted text struck through:
11	(c) The principal office shall review the applicant's financial responsibility based
12	upon the applicant's credit history <del>, ability to be bonded</del> and any history of bankruptcy
13	or assignment of receivers.
14	Section 8. Applications and Examinations. Hernando County Code Section 8-78(5)(e)
15	is hereby deleted in its entirety.
16	Section 9. Issuance; Bond Requirement; Proof of Liability, Property Damage and
17	Workers' Compensation Insurance. Hernando County Code Section 8-79 is hereby amended to
18	read as follows, with added text underlined and deleted text struck through:
19	Issuance; bond requirement; proof of liability, property damage and workers'
20	compensation insurance.

1	All persons acting in the capacity of a contractor including those persons
2	registered for the purpose of obtaining permits must provide proof of possessing a
3	five thousand dollar (\$5,000.00) bond, liability insurance if applicable and
4	compliance with workers' compensation. Upon approval by the principal office and
5	preparation of all appropriate documents, the applicant may be issued the certificate
6	of competency applied for, if applicable or registered for permitting purposes.
7	Applicants and/or contractors regulated by the Department of Business and
8	Professional Regulation must post a five thousand dollar (\$5,000.00) bond made
9	payable to the Construction Industry Recovery Fund to be filed with the Principal
10	Office of the Board. Bond requirements for state certified contractors shall be
11	effective April 1, 2002. Applicants and/or contractors regulated by the Hernando
12	County Construction Licensing Board or otherwise registered must post a five
13	thousand dollar (\$5,000.00) bond made payable to the Hernando County County
14	Development Department. The applicant must provide proof of public liability and
15	property damage insurance for the safety and welfare of the public in such amounts
16	as determined by the board if applicable. The applicant must provide proof of
17	workers' compensation insurance, as required by this code, Florida Statutes, and/or
18	federal law.

1	Section 10. Journeyman. Hernando County Code Section 8-82(5) is hereby amended to
2	read as follows, with added text underlined and deleted text struck through:
3	(5) Journeyman licenses do not require bond, liability insurance or worker's
4	compensation.
5	Section 11. Severability. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County
6	Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this
7	ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the
8	validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
9	Section 12. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intention of the Board of County
10	Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this
11	Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida.
12	To this end, the section of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such
13	intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section, "article," or other appropriate
14	designation.
15	Section 13. Conflicting Provisions Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
16	conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
17	Section 14. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of
18	official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance has
19	been filed with said office.
