2	AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY CODE § § 6-51(c)(5) TO

7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

9	Whereas, as the Florida Legislature, by enacting Chapter 2016-16, § 2, Laws of Florida, has
10	amended the procedures by which the owner of a dog that has been declared dangerous may appeal

12	Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners now wishes to amend its Code of Ordinances
13	to reflect this statutory change;
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

16	Section 1. Amendment of Dangerous Dog Appellate Procedures to Conform to Newly
17	Enacted Statute. Hernando County Code § 6-51(c)(5) is amended to read as follows:
18	(5) Once a dog is classified as a dangerous dog, the animal control authority shall
19	provide written notification to the owner by certified mail return receipt requested,
20	certified hand-delivery or service pursuant to chapter 48, Florida Statutes

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6	The owner may appeal the classification.
7	penalty, or both, by filing a notice of appeal with the circuit court in accordance with
8	Rule 9.190(b)(3), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. If the dog is not held by the
9	animal control authority, the owner must confine the dog in a securely fenced or
10	enclosed area pending resolution of the appeal.
11	Section 2. Severability. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County
12	Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this
13	ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the
14	validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
15	Section 3. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners
16	of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall
17	become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the
18	section of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention, and that
19	the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section, "article," or other appropriate designation.
