ORDINANCE NO.: 2017-3

AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING SCRIVENER’S ERRORS IN ORDINANCES 2016-19 AND 2016-20 BY ADDING INADVERTENTLY-OMITTED VERBIAGE REGARDING TEMPORARY USE OF GAS TAX PROCEEDS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY:

Section 1. Amendment of Carnes Area Road Paving MSBU. Hernando County Ordinance 2016-19, “Carnes Area Road Paving Municipal Service Benefit Unit,” is hereby amended to add a subpart E to Section IV, “ADMINISTRATION,” to read as follows:

E. The County intends to use legally available non-ad valorem revenues from the Constitutional Gas Tax Fund to finance the costs on an interim basis. The County intends to reimburse itself for the expenditure of such revenue from a draw upon the County’s line of credit upon the completion of the project, which amounts of such draw shall equal the cost of the project less any payments made by residents.

Section 2. Amendment of Painted Bunting Area Road Paving MSBU. Hernando County Ordinance 2016-20, “Painted Bunting Area Road Paving Municipal Service Benefit Unit,” is hereby amended to add a subpart E to Section IV, “ADMINISTRATION,” to read as follows:

1 E. The County intends to use legally available non-ad valorem revenues from
2 the Constitutional Gas Tax Fund to finance the costs on an interim basis. The
3 County intends to reimburse itself for the expenditure of such revenue from a draw
4 upon the County's line of credit upon the completion of the project, which amounts
5 of such draw shall equal the cost of the project less any payments made by residents.

6 **Section 3. Severability.** It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County
7 Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this
8 ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the
9 validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

10 **Section 4. Inclusion in the Code.** It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners
11 of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall
12 become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the
13 section of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention, and that
14 the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate designation.

15 **Section 5. Conflicting Provisions Repealed.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
16 conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


17 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of
18 official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance has
19 been filed with said office.




