2 3 4 5 6 7	AN ORDINANCE AMENDING Section 20-2, Hernando County Code, redefining all terrain vehicle (ATV); allowing ATV's to traverse certain unpaved county roads; providing for severability; providing for inclusion in the code; providing for the repeal of conflicting provisions; and providing for an effective date.

9	WHEREAS, on June 18, 2002, the Board of County Commissioners enacted Ordinance
10	2002-09, which among other things restricted ATV's from certain County owned properties; and
11	WHEREAS, on August 12, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners enacted this
12	Ordinance amending its Code, pursuant to Section 316.2123, Florida Statutes, which allows the
13	County to exempt itself from prohibiting the operation of an ATV upon designated upaved
14	roadways during the daytime as long as the designated roadway has a posted speed limit of less
15	than 35 miles per hour and is appropriately marked to indicate permissible ATV use; and
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
17	COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:
18	Section 1. Amend Ordinance 2002-09, codified as Ch 20, Art I, Section 20-2, (b), and
19	(c), Hernando County Code.
20	Section 2. 20-2, (b) Definitions. The following words and phrases when used in this
21	ordinance shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section, except where the
22	context otherwise requires:
23	All terrain vehicle (ATV") means any motorized off-highway or all terrain vehicle fifty (50)
24	inches or less in width, having a dry weight of six hundred (600) 1,200 pounds or less, designed to
25	travel traveling on three (3) or more low-pressure nonhighway tires, designed manufactured for
26	recreational use by one or more persons. operator use only with no passengers, having a seat or
27	saddle designed to be straddled by the operator, and having handlebars for steering control

Section 3. 20-2, (c): Presence of vehicles in, on, or upon drainage retention
areas, utility property or easements. It shall be a violation of this section for any motor
vehicle, including motorcycles and ATV's to be in, on, or upon any lakes, ponds, or
county drainage retention areas regardless whether the drainage retention area is denoted
as such by a sign or other notice. It shall further be a violation of this ordinance for any
motor vehicle including recreational or camper type vehicle, motorcycles and ATV's to
be in, on, or upon any right-of-way, easement, or utility property with electrical apparatus
or equipment including, but not limited to electric towers, electric transmission lines,
poles, or other support structures, fans, cooling apparatus, or transformers where the
utility is regulated either by the state public service commission or the natural rural
utilities service. This provision also applies to areas where any utility has an easement
within a right-of-way, including, but not necessarily limited to electric substations or
other apparatus used for the transmission or delivering of electricity even where such
equipment is isolated and stands apart. Further, it shall also be a violation of this
ordinance for anyone to damage such equipment including but not limited to hurling or
shooting any projectiles or missiles at any electric substation, other electrical generating
equipment, or towers or by hurling other objects including, but not limited to rocks,
stones, dirt, debris, or trash.

ATV's may be operated upon any upaved roadways in Hernando County where the posted speed limit is less than 35 miles per hour.

Section 4. Severability. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this

50	ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect
51	the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
52	Section 5. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intention of the Board of County
53	Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this
54	ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County,
55	Florida. To this end, the section of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish
56	such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or to another
57	appropriate designation.
58	Section 6. Conflicting Provisions Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances
59	in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
60	Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt
61	of official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance
62	has been filed with said office.
