ORDINANCE NO.: 2018 - 22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING HERNANDO COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 22, PARKS AND RECREATION, TO PROHIBIT THE TRANSFER OF PAID PARKING RIGHTS AND TO DECRIMINALIZE VIOLATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY:

Section 1. Amending Hernando County Code § 22-15. Hernando County Code § 22-15, Parking, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Parking.

- (a) No person shall park a vehicle, watercraft or trailer any place on park property other than in the regular designated facilities provided for that particular type of vehicle or vehicle and trailer, unless directed otherwise by law enforcement officers or park employees.
- (b) No person shall park or station any vehicle in any zone designated and marked "no parking," or otherwise marked for restricted use.
- (c) No person shall double park any vehicle at any time on any road or park area, unless so directed by a law enforcement officer or ~~park~~ an employee of Hernando County.
- (d) Any person parking in a pay designated parking space shall pay all parking fees required to cover the duration of time said vehicle is stopped, standing or parked in said space unless exempted under section 20-41 of this Code. The sharing or

1 transferring of parking passes, tickets, or any other indicia of paid access to pay-
2 designated parking spaces is strictly prohibited.

3 ~~(c) A violation of this section may be enforced as provided in chapter 20, article III~~
4 ~~(stopping, standing and parking) of this Code.~~

5 **Section 2. Amending Hernando County Code § 22-32.** Hernando County Code § 22-32, Penalties,
6 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 Penalties.

8 ~~Violation of any provision of this article other than section 22-12 shall constitute a~~
9 ~~misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided in section 1-8 of this Code. Violators of~~
10 ~~section 22-12 of this article shall be punished with a minimum sentence of a two-hundred-~~
11 ~~fifty-dollar fine.~~ Violation of any provisions of this article may be prosecuted as
12 described in Chapter 2, Article III, as it may be amended from time to time.

13 **Section 3. Severability.** It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that
14 if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held
15 unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
16 ordinance.

17 **Section 4. Inclusion in the Code.** It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of
18 Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and
19 be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the section of this
20 Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word “ordinance” may
21 be changed to “section,” “article,” or other appropriate designation.

1 **Section 5. Conflicting Provisions Repealed.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with
2 the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


3 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official
4 acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance has been filed with
5 said office.
