

ORDINANCE NO.: 2010- 14

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE HERNANDO COUNTY SHERIFF AS
HERNANDO COUNTY'S CHIEF CORRECTIONAL OFFICER; PROVIDING
FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS; REQUIRING THE
SHERIFF TO COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE LAWS AND REGULATIONS;
PROVIDING FOR THE INCLUSION OF CORRECTIONS EXPENSES IN
SHERIFF'S ANNUAL BUDGET REQUEST; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;
PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT;
PROVIDING FOR LIBERAL CONSTRUCTION; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION
IN THE HERNANDO COUNTY CODE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. Designation of Sheriff as Chief Correctional Officer. A new section of the
Hernando County Code is hereby created to read as follows:

Sheriff Designated Chief Correctional Officer

A. Pursuant to the provisions of Fla. Stat. § 951.061, the Hernando
County Sheriff is hereby designated as the Chief Correctional Officer.

B. The Hernando County Sheriff shall appoint such officers as he deems
necessary to assist him in the operation of the county's jail(s).

C. The Hernando County Sheriff shall enforce all existing state laws,
federal laws, and administrative rules concerning the operation and maintenance of
the county's jail(s).

1 D. The Sheriff shall include salaries for correctional officers in his/her
2 annual proposed budget of expenditures for the maintenance and operation of the
3 county's jail(s) as provided in Fla. Stat. § 30.49. The salaries for correctional officers
4 shall be paid from the general revenue fund of Hernando County.

5 **Section 2. Severability.**

6 It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section,
7 subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held
8 unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining
9 portions of this ordinance.

10 **Section 3. Inclusion in the Code.**

11 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and
12 it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the
13 Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, any section or subsection of this
14 Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance"
15 may be changed to "section, "article", or other appropriate designation.

16 **Section 4. Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict.**

17 Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

18 **Section 5. Effective Date.**

19 This ordinance shall take effect on August 27, 2010.
