ORDINANCE NO.: 2013- 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CONSOLIDATING THE **PROVISION** OF FIRE SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF SPRING HILL FIRE AND RESCUE MUNICIPAL SERVICES TAXING UNIT; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES AND ASSUMPTION OF DEBTS OF THE SPRING HILL FIRE AND RESCUE MUNICIPAL SERVICES TAXING UNIT; PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF HERNANDO BEACH MUNICIPAL SERVICES BENEFIT UNIT LEVY AND LIEN PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Repeal of Spring Hill Fire and Rescue Municipal Services Taxing Unit;

 Disposition of Assets and Liabilities and Assumption of Debts of the Spring Hill Fire and

 Rescue Municipal Services Taxing Unit
 - A. Sections 12-251 through 12-259 are repealed.
- B. All real and personal property titled in the name of the Spring Hill Fire and Rescue Municipal Services Taxing Unit shall be and become property of Hernando County, to be held for the benefit of the Spring Hill Fire and Rescue Municipal Services Taxing Unit and the citizens therein whose taxes have funded acquisition of such property, as required by Florida law. All debts and contracts of the Spring Hill Fire and Rescue Municipal Services Taxing Unit shall be deemed assigned to Hernando County, to the extent that such may be legally assigned.

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Section 2. Amendment of Hernando Beach Municipal Services Benefit Unit Finding of Facts and Purpose Provision. Hernando County Code § 12-76 is hereby amended to read as follows:

It is hereby found by the board of county commissioners that fire protection is an essential service for the benefit of the health, safety and welfare of the public. It is further the finding of the board of county commissioners that the Legislature has, in section 125.01(1)(q), Florida Statutes, provided for the creation of a municipal service taxing and benefit unit as a taxing vehicle to grant to all counties taxing flexibility to levy special service charges and special assessments within the limits fixed for municipal purposes for the furnishing of municipal services within those areas receiving the benefit of such municipal services in order to solve the controversy of double taxation between residents of the incorporated and unincorporated areas and in order to provide a needed and necessary service. It is the purpose of this division to create a county municipal service taxing benefit unit for the purpose of creating, establishing, maintaining and operating a fire protection system within the areas described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, and for the purpose of compensating the Hernando County Fire Rescue Department for the cost of providing fire suppression services within the geographic boundaries of the said unit.

1 Section 3. Amendment of Hernando Beach Municipal Services Benefit Unit Levy and Lien Provisions. 2 3 Hernando County Code Section 12-90.2 is hereby amended to read as follows: Same – Levy and lien provisions. 4 It being recognized that the value of the benefits accrued by virtue of this 5 (a) division directly benefits all lots within the unit, the county commission is 6 7 hereby authorized to levy an annual service charge against each lot within the unit for the purposes set forth herein. 8 9 The service charge shall charge shall be calculated as the sum of two (b) 10 components. The first component shall be the cost to each parcel for the 11 operation of the Hernando Beach Volunteer Fire Company. The second component shall be the cost to each parcel for the Hernando County Fire 12 Rescue Department's provision of aid to the Hernando Beach Volunteer Fire 13 14 Company, if any, within the geographic boundaries of Hernando Beach Municipal Fire Service Unit during the preceding fiscal year. 15 The service charge imposed hereunder shall constitute a lien on all real 16 (c) property of the unit as of the date ad valorem taxes become liens. Unless fully 17 paid and discharged or barred by law, said annual service charges shall 18 19 remain liens equal in rank and dignity with the lien of county ad valorem taxes and superior in rank and dignity to all other liens, encumbrances, titles 20

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and claims in, to or against the real property involved. If the annual assessment levied on a lot is not paid, a tax certificate pertaining to the property may be sold by the tax collector as set forth in Chapter 197, Florida Statutes.

(b)(d) Special provisions. For property requiring special services from the unit, the unit shall be authorized and empowered to enter into service contracts to provide such special service to any property. The charge to be made for such special service contracts shall be reflected in the contract pursuant to standards promulgated by the unit.

Section 4. Severability

It is declared to be the intent of the board of county commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Inclusion in the Code

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the section of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate designation.
