ORDINANCE NO.: 2017 - 6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY,
FLORIDA REPEALING THE “HERNANDO COUNTY MOSQUITO CONTROL
MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT”; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;
PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL
OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (“the Board”), pursuant to the provisions
of Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, has the power to establish, merge or abolish municipal service
taxing units and levy and ad valorem property taxes within such units; and,

WHEREAS, the Board, on June 14, 2011, adopted Ordinance No. 2011-11, which created
the Hernando County Mosquito Control Municipal Service Taxing Unit (“the Unit”) to fund the
provision of mosquito control services within the Unit; and,

WHEREAS, since 2014, the Board has annually adopted an millage rate of Zero Mills for
the properties located within the Unit; and,

WHEREAS, the purposes of the Unit have been accomplished;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY:

1 **Section 1. Repeal of the Unit.** Hernando County Code §§ 15-221 through 15-226
2 inclusive, creating the Hernando County Mosquito Control Municipal Service Taxing Unit, are
3 hereby repealed.

4 **Section 2. Severability.** It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County
5 Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this
6 ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the
7 validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

8 **Section 3. Inclusion in the Code.** It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners
9 of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall
10 become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the
11 section of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention, and that
12 the word “ordinance” may be changed to “section,” “article,” or another appropriate designation.

13 **Section 4. Conflicting Provisions Repealed.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
14 conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

15 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of
16 official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance has
17 been filed with said office.
