3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY  
4 COMMISSIONERS REGARDING BUILDING CODES; PROVIDING FOR THE  
5 REPEAL OF PREEMPTED OR OTHERWISE ANACHRONISTIC SECTIONS;  
6 PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE FENCE CODE FROM HERNANDO  
7 COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 8 TO CHAPTER 10; PROVIDING FOR  
8 SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING  
9 FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR  
10 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
12 COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY:

13 **Section 1. Repeal of Preempted or Otherwise Anachronistic Sections.**

14 Hernando County Code Ch. 8, Art. II, Division 3 (“Amusement Device Code”), Ch. 8, Art.  
15 II, Division 9 (“Solar Energy Heating and Cooling Devices”), Ch. 8, Art. II, Division 11 (“Fuel  
16 Code”), Ch. 8, Art. II, Division 12 (“Code for the Storage and Handling of Liquefied Petroleum  
17 Gases”), Ch. 8, Art. IV (“Costal Construction Code”), and Ch. 8, Art. VI (“Natural Gas Code”) are  
18 hereby repealed.

1           **Section 2. Transfer of Fence Code.** A new Hernando County Code Ch. 10, Art. III, to be  
2 entitled “Fence Code,” is hereby created. Hernando County Code §§ 8-210.11 through 8-210.18,  
3 inclusive, relating to fences, are hereby transferred to Hernando County Code Ch. 10, Art. III, and  
4 shall become Hernando County Code §§ 10-51 through 10-58, respectively.

5           **Section 3. Severability.** It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County  
6 Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this  
7 ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the  
8 validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

9           **Section 4. Inclusion in the Code.** It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners  
10 of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall  
11 become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the  
12 sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that  
13 the word “ordinance” may be changed to “section” or “article” or other appropriate designation.

14           **Section 5. Conflicting Provisions Repealed.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in  
15 conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

16           **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of  
17 official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance has  
18 been filed with said office.
