9 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF**  
10 **HERNANDO COUNTY:**

11 **Section 1. Repeal of Hernando County Disturbing Sound in Connection with**  
12 **Alcoholic Beverage Licensed Locations Ordinance.**

13 Article II, Sections 4-21 through 4-27 of the Hernando County Code, the Hernando County  
14 Disturbing Sound in Connection with Alcoholic Beverage Licensed Locations Ordinance, is hereby  
15 repealed in its entirety.

16 **Section 2. Severability.**

17 It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section,  
18 subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held  
19 unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining  
20 portions of this ordinance.

21 **Section 3. Inclusion in the Code.**

22 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and  
23 it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the

Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, any section or subsection of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention, and the word “ordinance” may be changed to “section,” “article,” or any other appropriate designation.

**Section 4. Effective date.**
