ORDINANCE NO.: 2019-5

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING DIVISION 180, ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 24 OF THE HERNANDO COUNTY CODE, JOHNATHAN DR. ROAD PAVING MUNICIPAL SERVICE BENEFIT UNIT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners enacted Ordinance 2018-24, codified as Division 180, Article III of Hernando County Code Ch. 24, creating the “Johnathan Dr. Road Paving Municipal Service Benefit Unit”; and,

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners determined that the above-referenced ordinance should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HERNANDO COUNTY:

Section 1. Repeal of Johnathan Dr. Road Paving Municipal Service Benefit Unit.

Hernando County Code §§ 24-1976 through 24-1980, inclusive, are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Severability.

It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Inclusion in the Code.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby provided, that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of

1 the Code of Ordinances of Hernando County, Florida. To this end, the section of this ordinance may
2 be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be
3 changed to "section," "article," or to another appropriate designation.

4 **Section 4. Conflicting Provisions Repealed.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
5 conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

6 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of
7 official acknowledgment from the office of the Secretary of State of Florida that this ordinance has
8 been filed with said office.
