2 less than eighteen (18) months after the construction project is completed. An inspection shall be  
3 requested by the applicant and upon finding that all landscape requirements have received the  
4 proper care and maintenance for long-term survival, the bond may be released.

6 **Sec. 10-30. – Exemptions.**

8 (c) The following are exempt from the bond or other surety requirement in Section 10-  
9 22(h) regarding land clearing permits:

10 (1) An applicant who has a contract with the County for the construction of a  
11 public building, for the prosecution and completion of a public work, or for repairs upon a public  
12 building or public work, who is already required to execute and record in the public records of the  
13 County, a payment and performance bond pursuant to Section 255.05, Florida Statutes.

15 **Section 2. Severability.** It is hereby declared the intent of the Board of County  
16 Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, that if any section, subsection, clause, sentence,  
17 phrase, or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the  
18 invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

19 **Section 3. Inclusion in the Code.** It is hereby declared the intent of the Board of  
20 County Commissioners of Hernando County, Florida, and it is hereby directed, that the provisions  
21 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the *Code of Ordinances, Hernando County,*  
22 *Florida.* To this end, the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish  
23 such intention, and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or any other  
24 appropriate designation.

25 **Section 4. Conflicting Provisions Repealed.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances  
26 in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
