ORDINANCE NO.: 2023 -1 AN ORDINANCE MERGING THE HOLLAND SPRINGS MULTI-PURPOSE, 2 THE BARONY WOODS EAST STREET LIGHTING, AND THE HOLLAND 3 4 SPRING INDUSTRIAL PARK STREET LIGHTING MUNICIPAL SERVICES 5 BENEFIT UNITS INTO THE WEST HERNANDO STREET LIGHTING MUNICIPAL SERVICES BENEFIT UNIT; PROVIDING FOR 6 INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; REPEALING TO-BE-MERGED MUNICIPAL 7 8 SERVICES BENEFIT UNITS; AMENDING THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF THE 9 WEST HERNANDO STREET LIGHTING MUNICIPAL SERVICES BENEFIT UNIT; PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER/REFUND OF REMAINING FUNDS; 10 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE 11 CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND 12 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 13 14 WHEREAS, a recent analysis performed by the Department of Public Works has revealed 15 that due to rising operational costs and the depletion of reserves, the amount of the annual 16 assessments to be levied by the Holland Springs Multi-Purpose, the Barony Woods East Street 17 Lighting, and the Holland Spring Industrial Park Street Lighting Municipal Services Benefit Units 18 19 ("MSBU's) will have to increase sharply in the near future; and, WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works' analysis found the best way to limit the future 20 21 assessment increases on the parcels within the above-referenced MSBU's is to merge those small 22 MSBU's into the much larger West Hernando Street Lighting MSBU.
